The glass walled double-height Grand Lobby of the Roger Williams Hotel, is a shrine to Modernism. The finely honed limestone interior echoes the limestone exterior both engineered and built by Urban D.C. This exquisite hotel designed by Rafael Vinoly, "...appears to have been transplanted from the Armani end of the Avenue," said New York Magazine.

Specialty contractor, Urban D.C., cleaned and pointed the exterior of this mid-20th century building and restored and replicated the terra cotta architectural elements. Urban D.C.'s team engineered the massive openings, then fabricated and installed structural steel to expose the interior of the hotel lobby to Madison Avenue.

Urban D.C. has successfully completed full exterior restoration on other boutique hotels including The Hotel Wales, The Shorham and The Mansfield, all formerly of The Gotham Hotel Group.
